AA AND ANONYMITY

Two of A.A.'s traditions address anonymity. The Eleventh Tradition states that our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films. The Twelfth Tradition says that Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our Traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities. With these Traditions in mind, taking a picture of people attending an AA event could be a violation of the anonymity principle.

At an event someone was taking photographs or a video of a group of people listening to an AA speaker. These people has no idea that they were being photographed. I have personally experienced a time when I was showing a friend of mine a photo of several women who attended an AA luncheon. That person, not an alcoholic, said something like, isn't that --- ---. (This person was the wife of a local attorney.) Where was this and how do you know her? I told her it was at a luncheon and that we had a friend in common that introduced us. Luckily, she did not pursue it further. So, something as innocent as a photo of a group of your friends can break their anonymity. It is important that people are asked if they mind having their photo taken first. Caution should also be exercised in how the photo is shared. Renee R.
